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



During the academic year 2020-2021, Department of Mathematics, Mar Thoma College for Women, Perumbavoor organised online CSIR-UGC-NET/JRF coaching for PG students of our department to provide an online platform for practice problems. The coaching was conducted through Google Meet platform. The classes were 2 hours per day and took 28 hours in total. 5 students of our PG program had participated in the session and utilised their opportunity to perform better in their regular studies and also in competitive exams. Interested students from B.Sc. Mathematics also attended certain sessions. Mr. Gopikrishna S. Nair, faculty of the 10



department handled the classes. These sessions empower and enrich the students to face the competitive exams. The classes started with discussion of CSIR-UGC-NET/JRF syllabus in detail and enlightened the students with numerous job opportunities available in the field of teaching and research. This coaching had followed the syllabus of CSIR-UGC-NET/JRF in Mathematical Sciences. Five topics were covered during the classes. They were Linear Algebra, Real Analysis, Abstract Algebra, Complex Analysis and Differential Equations. Basic theory portions were discussed from these topics and more concentration was on solving the previous year questions. This coaching had achieved its objective and thus the participating students effectively continued their journey towards success. These classes motivated the students to prepare for competitive examinations and to clarify their doubts in connection with the exams.







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



Screenshots of JAM coaching class by Dr. Rajani Jacob

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
