Report 2021-2022

Two meetings of the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) were convened during the academic year 2021-22 to review its functioning and also to plan further course of action. Programs relating to gender equality, self defense and protection were conducted during the academic year to sensitize and create awareness among the students. Mentoring of students was also done regularly so that students can voice out their concerns freely and openly. The student counsellor interacts with students and monitors their psychological well-being.



The NSS in association with Women and Child Development Department organsied a Gender Sensitisation Campaign 'Kanal' from 01st to 3rd September 2021. On September 1, a session on 'Gender Relations' was handled by Prof Dr. Shamshad Hussain K T, Sree Shankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Kalady. On 3rd September, a session on the topic' Gender and Law' was handled by Adv. Ferha Azeez, High Court of Kerala. Both these sessions were highly useful for the students.

The College Union and Arts Club observed the 'International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women' on 25 Nov 2021. Dr. Reshma Bharadwaj, Assistant Professor, Dept of Social Work, Sree Shankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Kalady was the resource person for the session, who talked on the role of womens' rights movements in preventing and eliminating violence against women and girls and the need to mobilise more people to support the efforts in ending such violence.

The English Association organised a round table conference in which the topic for discussion was 'Do dowry deaths reveal the true picture of gender relations in India?' on 2nd December 2021. Students actively participated in the same.

All the above programs proved to be highly effective in creating awareness and understanding among the students.
