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
### **INTRODUCTION**



Water samples were collected from flood affected areas of KoovappadyPanchayath for analysis in our Chemistry lab by testing the pH & CO<sub>2</sub> content and the results were distributed. NSS Volunteers attended the training programme and super chlorination and carried this out in 60 houses in Vallom.
