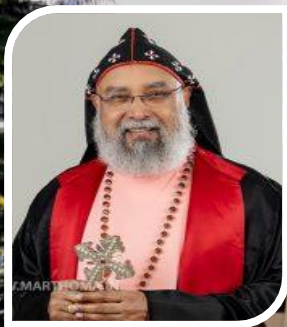

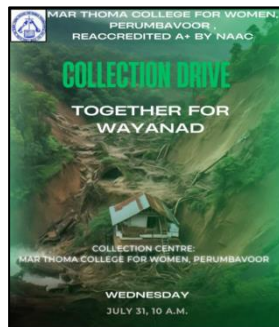
The Moment

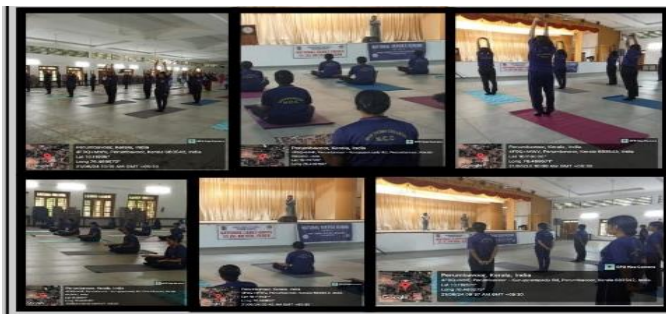


International Yoga Day

Protest March

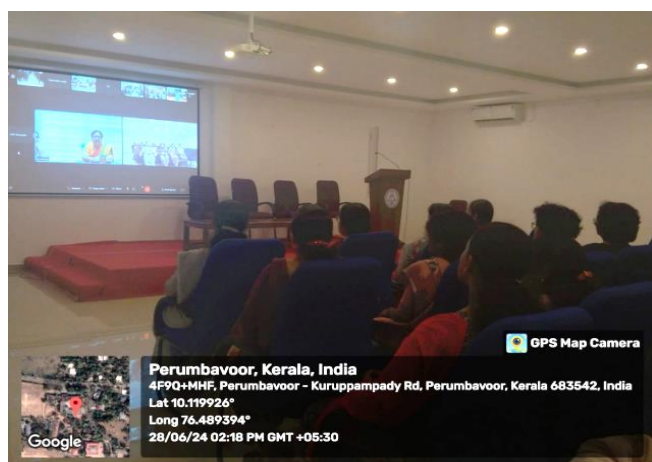

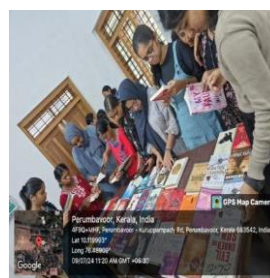
