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FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

Conducting feedback analysis is a vital process for the College for continuous improvement. It involves systematically collecting, interpreting, and utilizing feedback to enhance decision-making, refine processes, and achieve goals. The feedback analysis is an essential tool for the achievement of our excellence. By understanding and acting on the feedback, we make informed decisions, adapt to changing circumstances, and maintain a competitive edge.

Student Feedback Analysis Report 2023 - 2024

Student feedback on the curriculum and its implementation is collected every year. 89.1% of students agree that the Programme has been designed to fulfil the demands of the changing job prospects. Majority of the students agree that the curriculum is supported through experiential learning. 85% agree that the open /choice based/elective courses are appropriate to the current demands. 71.4% agree that the syllabus is a balanced combination of theory and application. Most of the students agree that study materials are available for the Courses. 78.2% of students agree that a clean and healthy classroom environment of the Institution improves the quality of learning. Majority of the students agree that the Library ambience provides sufficient informal learning. A happy 87.8% of students agree that the co-curricular ambience of the Institution gives enough flexibility for students to explore themselves. 87.1% agree that the laboratory environment enables effective learning and understanding of experiments. Most of the students agree that the availability of teachers for discussion and guidance improves academic performance. 82.2% agree that there is clarity in the rules of the evaluation process that has improved the academic performance. 83% of students agree that the teachers have been instrumental to compensate for any inadequacy of information in textbooks. A large majority agree that they have been able to attain the goals of the Programme. Student feedback is a cornerstone of effective institutional management, providing actionable insights that contribute to a better learning environment, improved teaching practices as well as an enhanced overall student experience. The analysis of the feedback helps foster a culture of accountability, growth, and student-centred development.

Teacher Feedback Analysis Report 2023-2024

The teacher feedback on the institution's infrastructure, curriculum, and its implementation is gathered annually to assess areas of strength and identify potential improvements. The feedback covers key aspects such as curriculum enrichment, infrastructure support, employability focus, and the overall teaching-learning environment. The analysis provides valuable insights into the effectiveness of the institution's resources and policies in enhancing both academic and co-curricular activities. 60% of the teachers strongly agree that curriculum enrichment activities, particularly those promoting gender equality, human values, and environmental awareness, are actively encouraged by the institution. 70% of the teachers agree that the general ambience of the college fosters productive interaction between stakeholders, contributing to a collaborative academic environment. 50% of the teachers strongly agree that the library provides adequate resources for both curriculum reference and research enhancement. 60% of the teachers strongly agree that the available infrastructure sufficiently supports the requirements of the teaching and learning processes. Most teachers believe that the college's programs and curriculum are better enriched compared to similar programs offered by other universities. 60% of the teachers agree that employability is given due consideration during curriculum design and development, aligning academic learning with industry demands. The majority of teachers also agree that having representation from business and industry in the Boards of Studies significantly contributes to the improvement and relevance of courses. This feedback analysis highlights the institution's commitment to maintaining a conducive environment for learning and its efforts to align the curriculum with both societal values and market demands.
