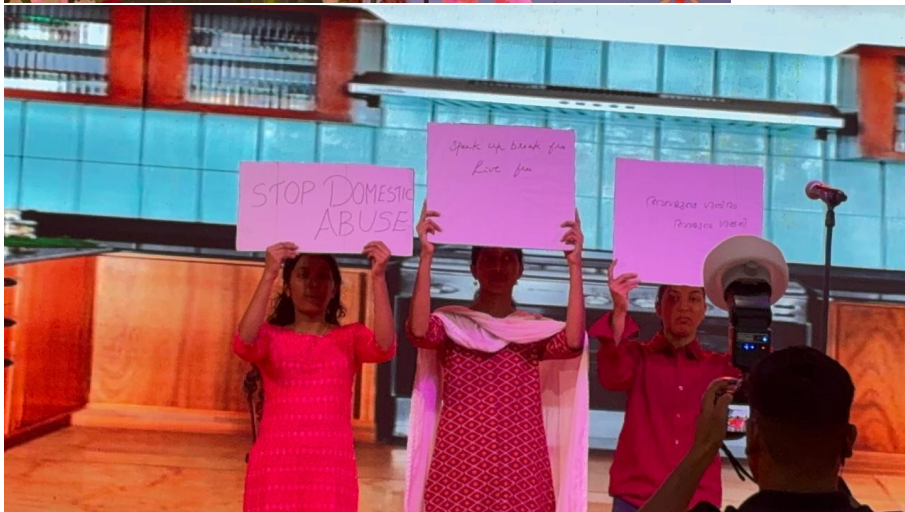


MAR THOMA COLLEGE FOR WOMEN PERUMBAVOOR
