5 JULY 2019 ACTIVITIES


1. Mass Awareness Rally

plastic eradication and to encourage the use of paper products for a green environment.






10 JULY 2019 ACTIVITIES


LOGO AND CAPTION DESIGNING COMPETITION

3. WATER POLLUTION SURVEY NEARBY HOUSES


