

- Introduce online teaching methodologies and facilities to upload online course materials.
- Online remedial sessions shall be conducted.
- Enrichment activities to manage COVID-19 pandemic shall be conducted.
- Promote innovation and entrepreneurship activities
- Encourage faculty members to attend online FDPs, short term courses, etc.
- Programmes on enriching national integration, secularism, gender sensitivity shall be conducted.
- More ICT facilities to be provided

- Learning Management System Moodle was purchased for the conduct of online classes.
- Online teaching reports were collected from teachers by LAKSHYA, a subcommittee of IQAC.
- College placed an application to be a nodal centre of Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development Centre of Government of Kerala and received approval for the same.
- Classes on human values to be conducted on Wednesdays by external experts.
- 4 Online Open House sessions were organized.
- Enrolment in online courses were encouraged. This was facilitated by the college as the institution got recognition as the nodal centre of Coursera.
- Departments and clubs took initiatives to organise programs on National integration, women empowerment.
- Around 15 laptops were added to the IT facility of the institution.

- Encourage research aptitude and practices


- Workshops on interview skills, resume writing, group discussions were conducted by various departments
