



Report





Figure 1: Attendance of the Students






Figure 2: Screenshot of the Q2 Meeting






Figure 3: Screenshot of the Q2 Meeting




Figure 4: Screenshot of the Q3 Meeting




Figure 7: Screenshot of the Activity




Figure 11: Photograph of the Progress Monitoring Visit




Figure 1: Workshop - Brochure


Figure 3: Photos of the Programme




Figure 1: Program Brochure






Figure 1: Program Brochure




Figure 2: Screenshot of the Program


Invited Lecture on "Film Studies: An Introduction"
