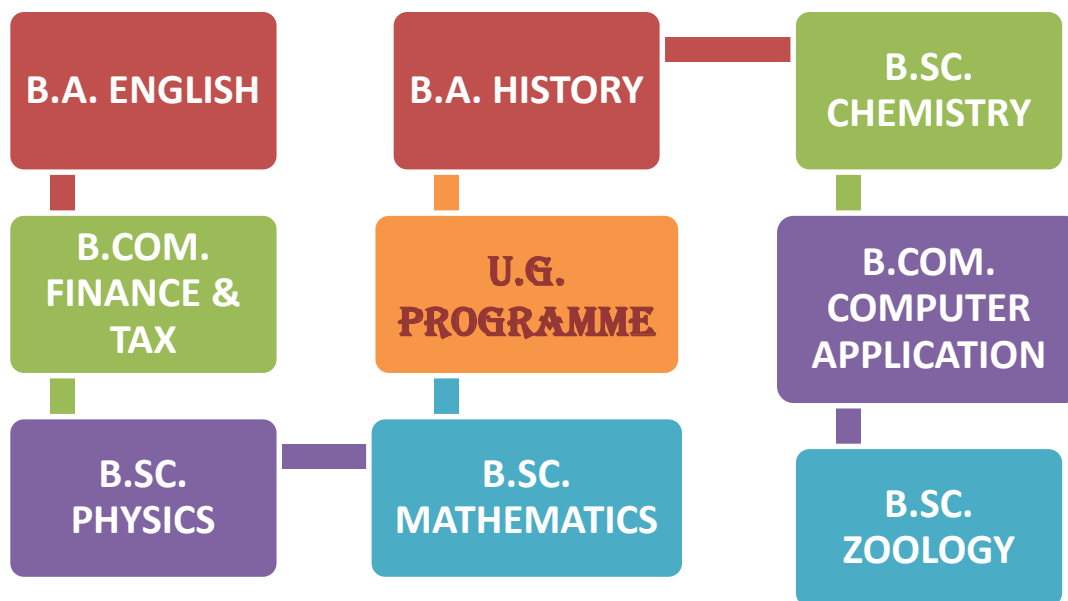

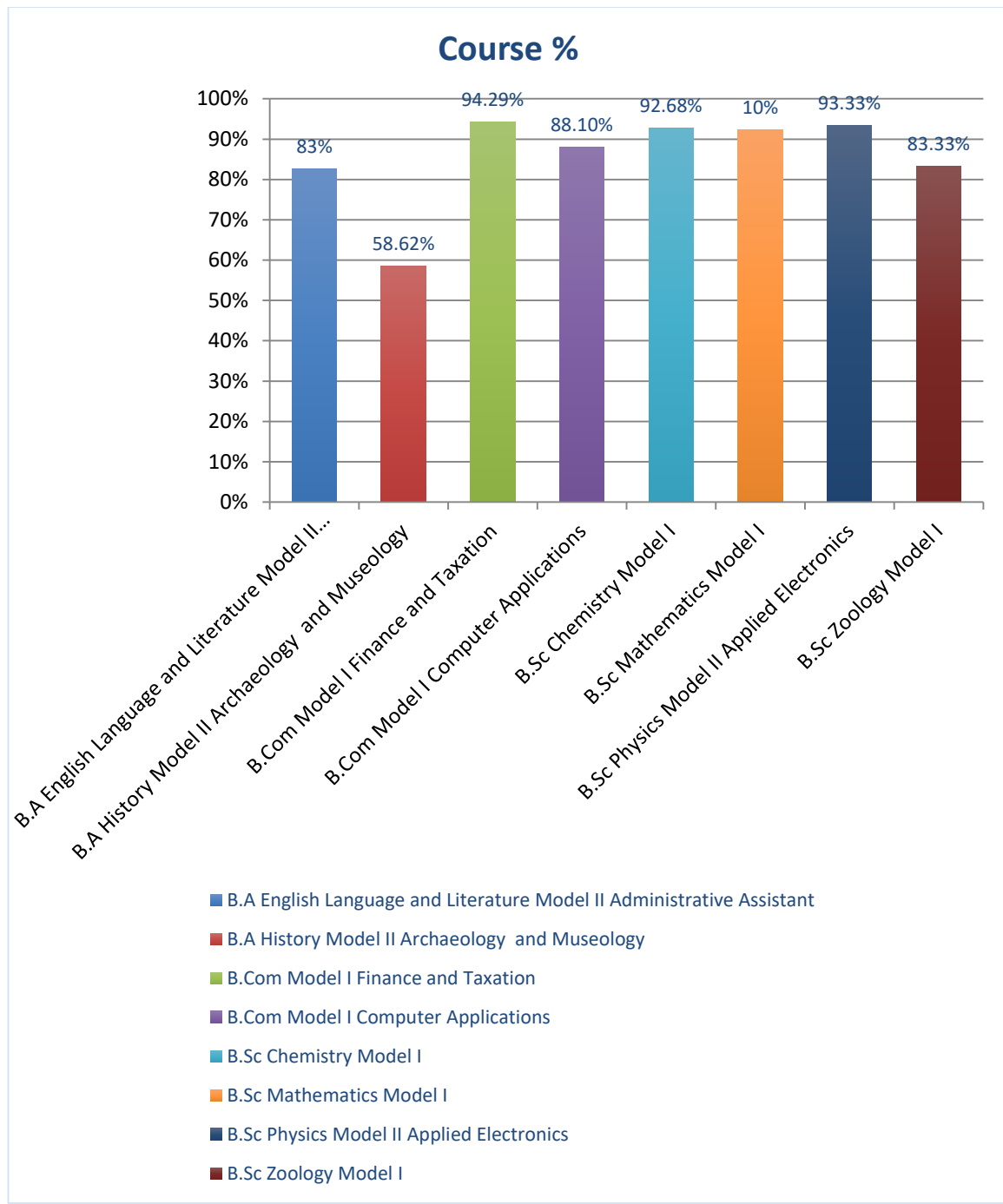

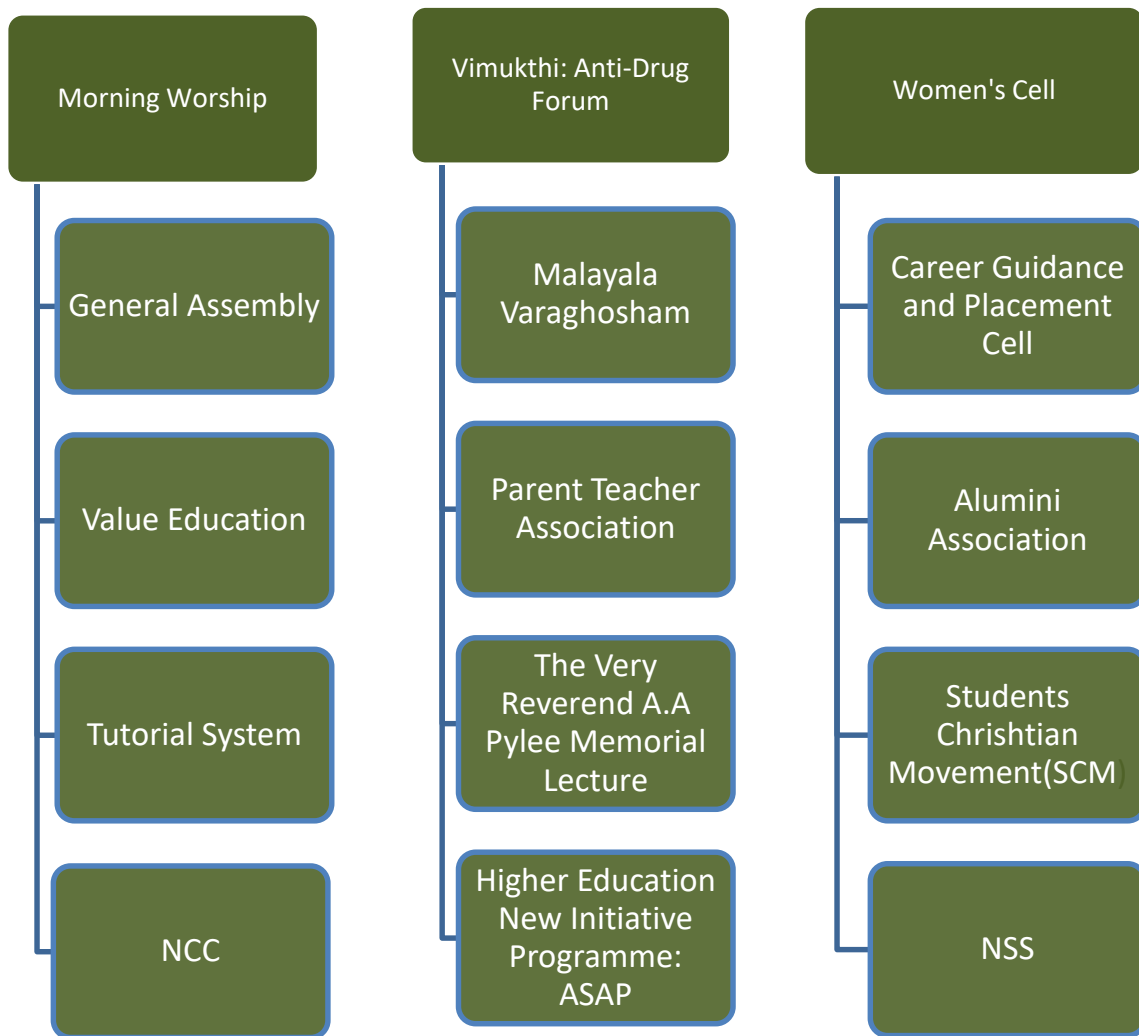

Zoology Association

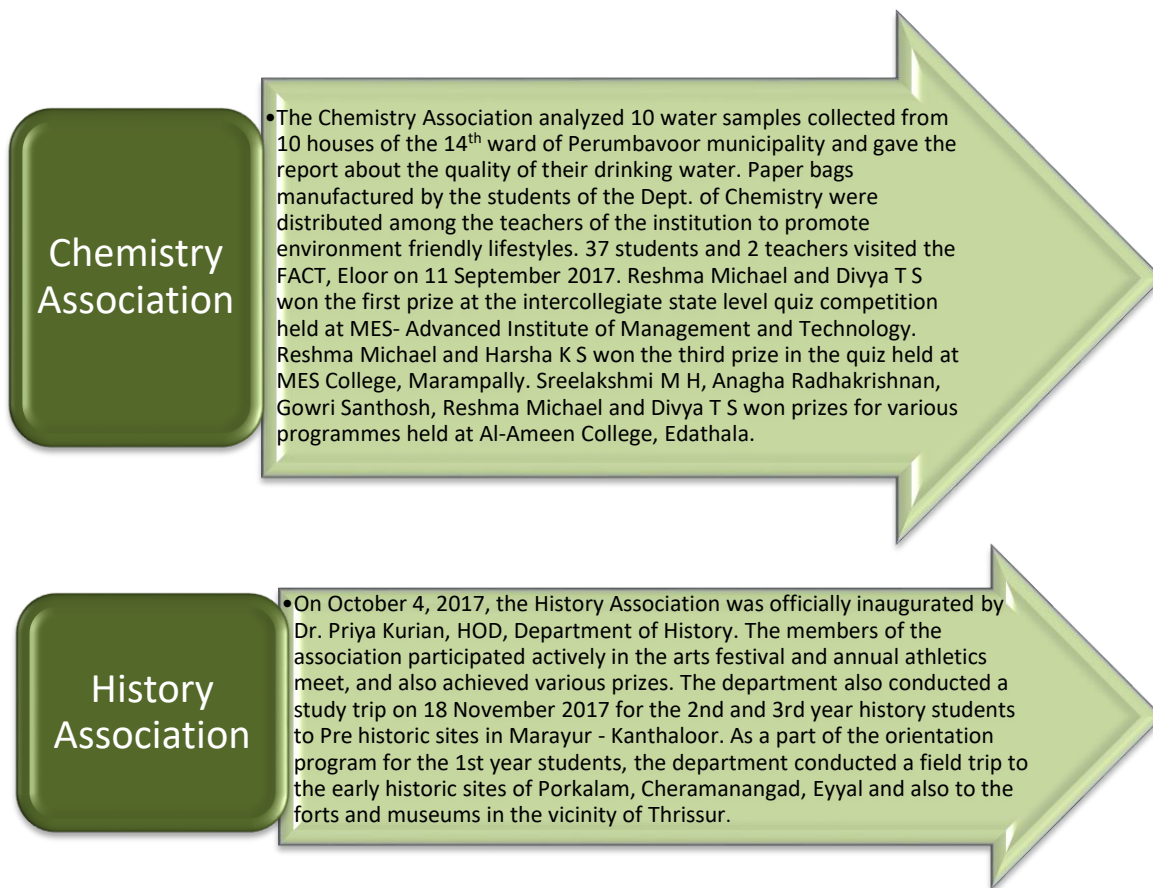
