INTRODUCTION

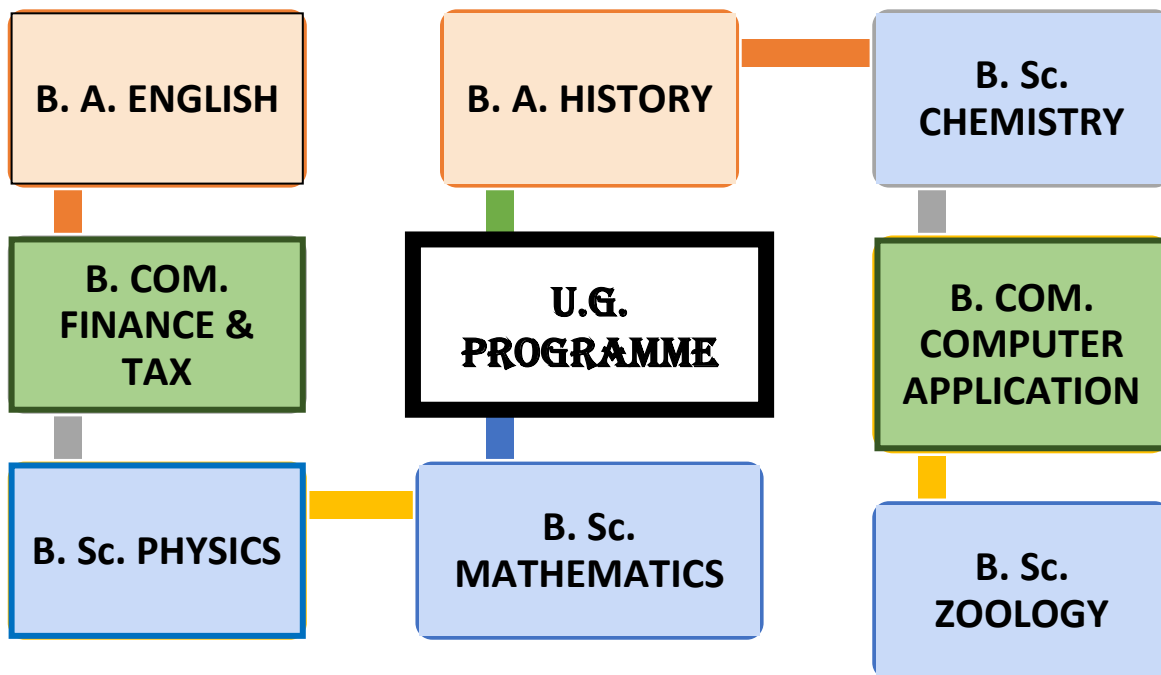

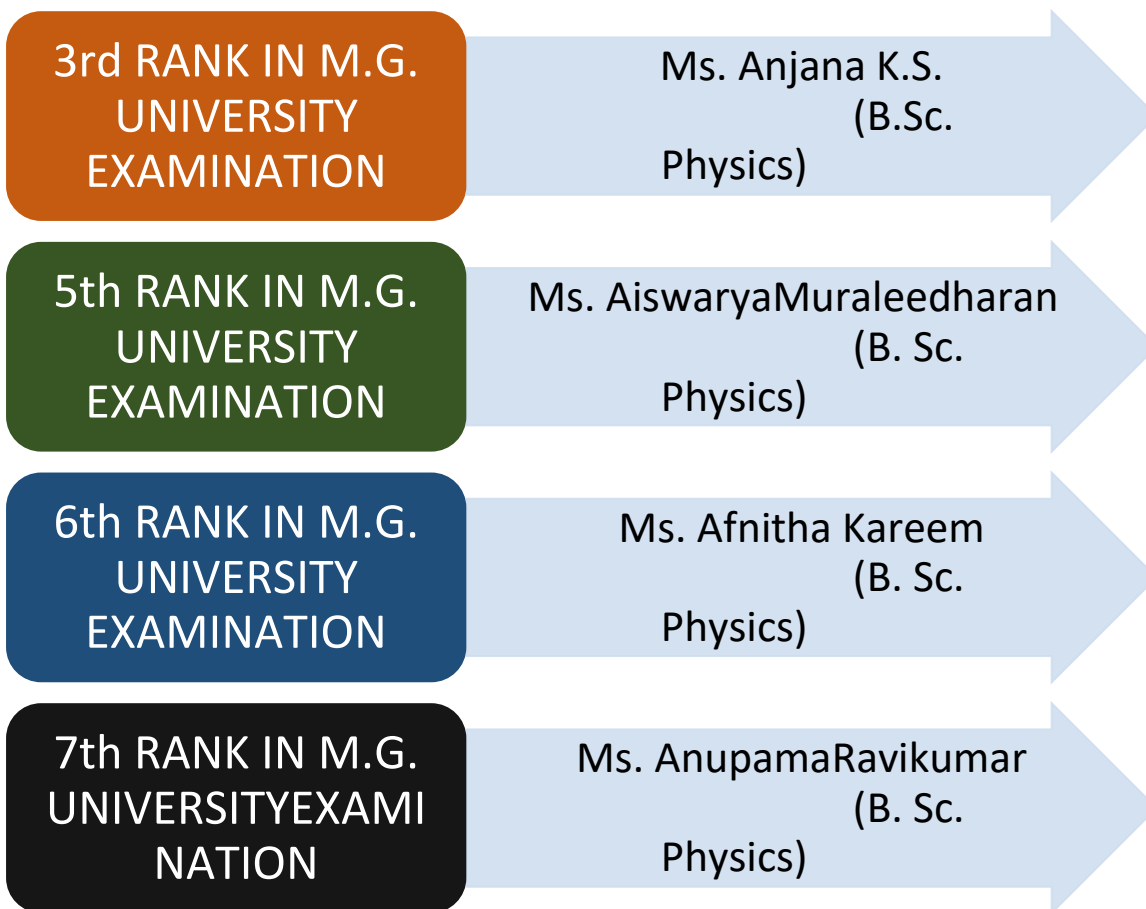

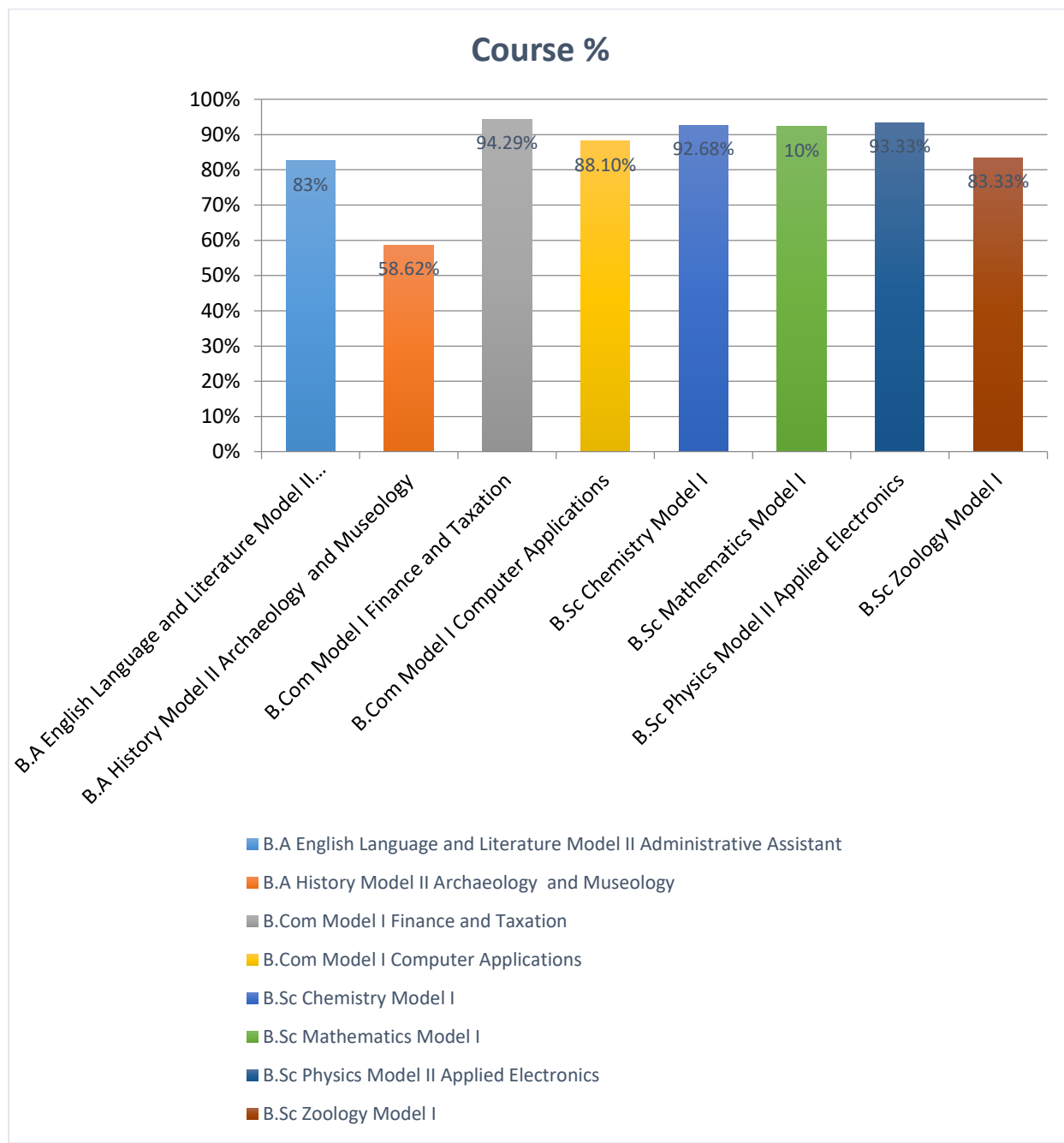
