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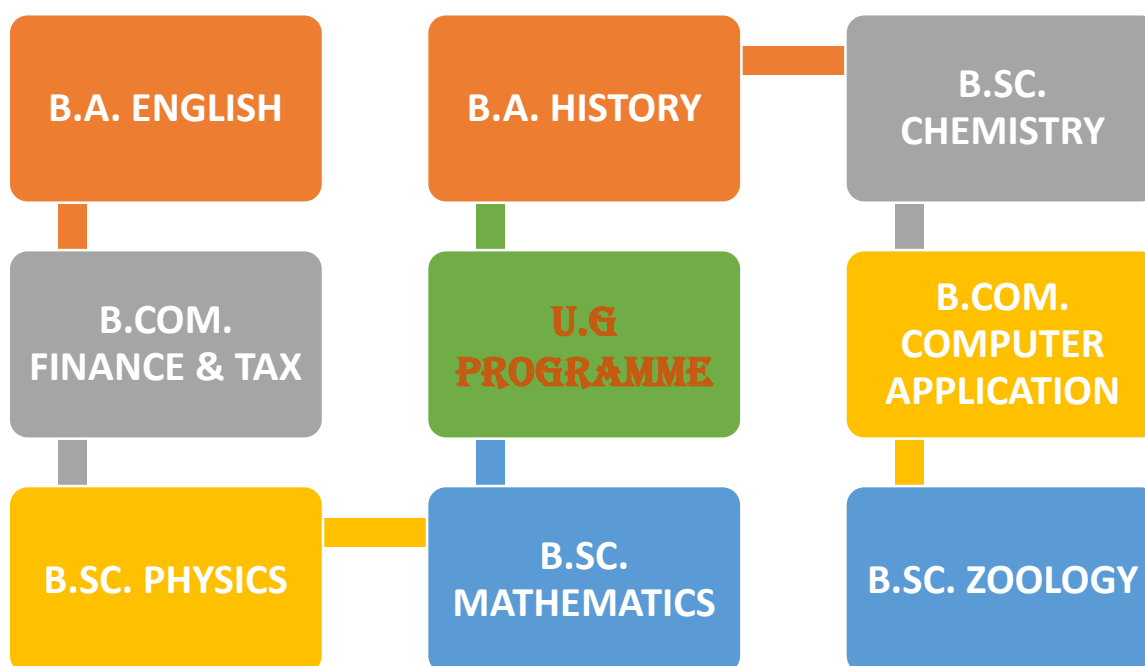

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ADMISSION AND COMMENCEMENT OF CLASSES

- ❖ The College opened after mid – summer vacation on 1 June, 21. The classes for the Academic Year 2021-22 commenced on 1 June 2021. Due to the prevailing pandemic situation and lockdown classes were conducted on online mode through LMS platform. An Orientation Programme was conducted for the students by College Union and Arts club on 22 June,2021 and the message was delivered by Rev. Dr. Abraham Mathew, Director, Mar Thoma Guidance Centre, Vytilla. The offline classes for the Final year degree students started on 04 October,2021. The classes were started following Covid Protocol and a Covid Jagratha Committee was formed for the same involving participation from the Fire Force Department, Police Department, Health Department, Staff and students of the college.
- ❖ The Centralised Allotment Process of Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam, for First Year UG & PG programmes started in the month of August. The online Classes for First Year UG and PG courses commenced on 28 October,2021 and 1 December 2021 respectively. The classes for first year degree students commenced from 25 October, 2022. A prayer service was conducted on 26 October,2021 by Rev. Daniel Mathew on 26 October,2022. An induction ceremony was organized for the newly inducted +first year students on 29 September,2021. Mr Rishi Raj Singh IPS, Former DGP, Prisons and Correctional Services Government of Kerala delivered the main message.
- ❖ The total number of students who enrolled in both Aided & Self-Financing streams for the year is 363. The total student strength as in December 2021 is 888. Dr. Vineed Kumar K, Director of Physical Education served as the Nodal Officer for the MG University CAP Admission process.

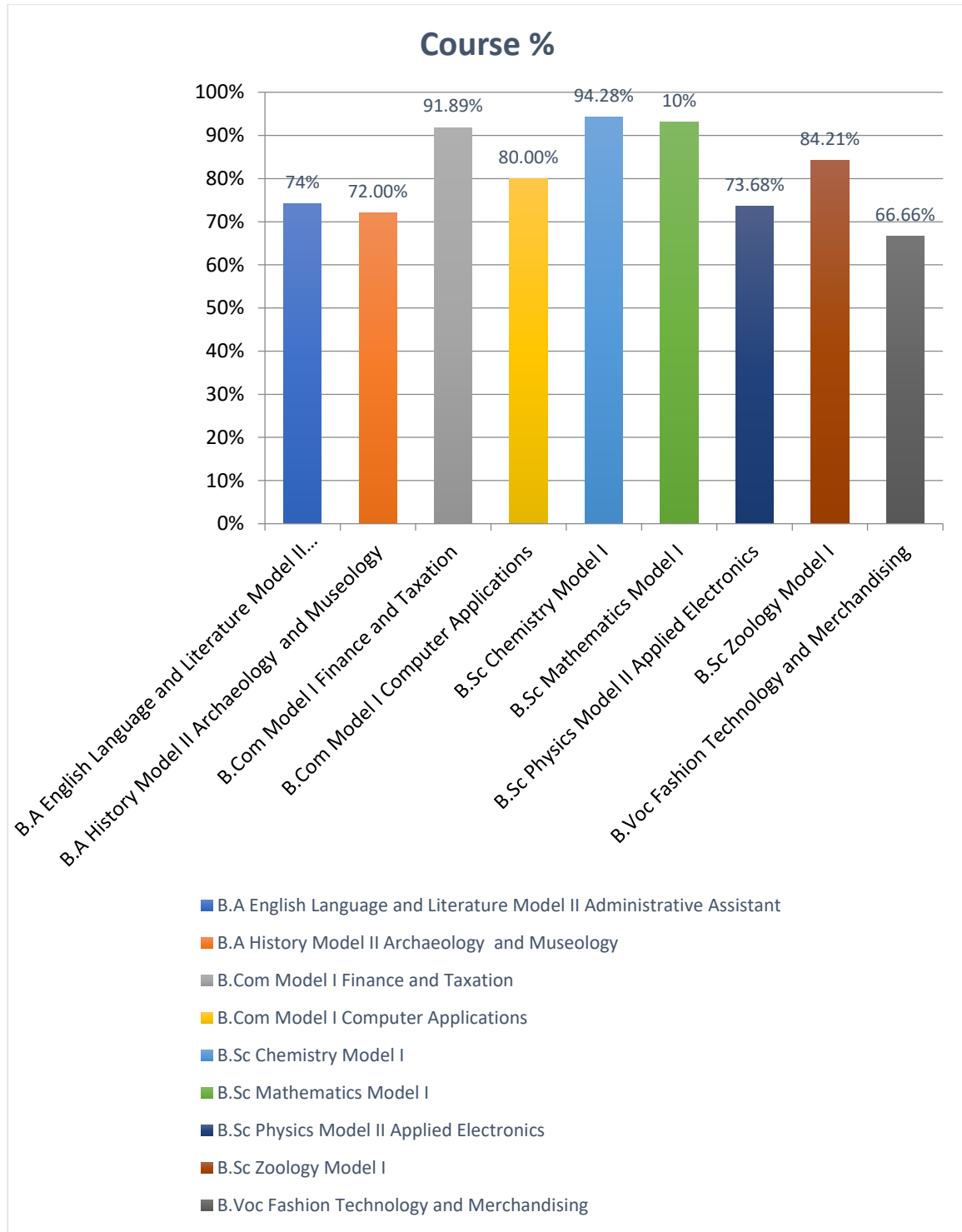

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INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL(IQAC)

The IQAC plays a major role in the overall development of the College by initiating academic and extra-curricular activities of benefit to the students as well as the local community. This year, the IQAC has had increased responsibilities in the wake of the transformations in the education sector owing to the Covid-19 situation. The paradigm shift to the online mode of learning and knowledge dissemination was facilitated by the IQAC in the College. The Cell took the initiative in purchasing and utilizing Moodle as a Learning Management System and provided guidance to both teachers and students in teaching and learning online. Teachers were encouraged to use LMS for teaching online. Flipped classroom system was adopted whenever possible. More than 25 webinars and online workshops were conducted by various departments and clubs in association with the IQAC. The Cell also played an active role in motivating teachers to improve their ICT skills by encouraging them to participate in FDPs, workshops and courses, especially those on online teaching methods and also conducted an FDP on LMS and e-content tool and an initial level training on deQ Accreditation app. The Institution's Innovation Council (IIC), a project of the MHRD, guided by the IQAC, obtained three-star rating this year. The Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development Centre (IEDC) of Kerala Start up Mission in the College continued its activities with vigor. Under the guidance of the Cell, the institution applied for NIRF for the third time and ARIIA ranking for the second time. The IQAC took the initiative in applying for various courses in conventional and new generation category. Under new generation scheme, an Integrated 5-Year MSc Programme in Basic Science- Physics was granted to the College. Three Diploma courses, DTP and Office Management, Beauty Parlour Management and Airport Management and Ground Handling were also granted by Youth Employability Skill Training Educational Cooperative Society. The College, under the auspices of the IQAC, assisted the government and community in combating Covid-19. The College was recognized as a member of Beat Covid Campaign initiative of Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education, Hyderabad. The Covid Monitoring



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Committee was formed with representatives from the staff, students and the community. Students manufactured masks and sanitizers and awareness campaigns were conducted by the College. The Green Campus Initiative was strengthened. E-submission of assignments was encouraged and exams were conducted online to reduce paper waste. Organic farming was initiated and students were instructed to grow plants organically at home. The College has also been recognized as a member of the National Rural Entrepreneurship Mission with the IQAC taking the initiative in constituting the Rural Entrepreneurship Development Cell in the Campus. A webinar on “Intellectual Property Rights” was organized by the IQAC in association with the Central Library, KSCSTE and Patent Office, Chennai.

The AQAR for the academic year 2020-21 is being prepared for final submission. Various sub-committees of IQAC, namely SHAKTI for the monitoring of online programmes, VEEKSHAN for collecting and analyzing feedback, LAKSHYA for supervision of e-facilities and The Voice for grievance redressal were reconstituted. The IQAC monitors the activities of all the clubs and cells in the College and ensures that quality initiatives are undertaken.

The IQAC remains committed to working for the overall progress of the College, contributing proactively to all facets of its development.
