
After the election, staff coordinator Dr. Vinod V has explained the facilities that the college wishes to provide to the Alumnae in the coming academic years. The facilities include:

- Creating placement executive committee meeting twice or thrice in an academic year, before the annual meeting to monitor the running of the Alumnae Association.



















Department of Zoology




Outcome: Learning from the experience of like-minded people was encouraging and more effective.


Academic Support




Donations

Alumni Lecture Series



The English Association in association with IQAC conducted a workshop on how to crack NET and preparatory steps that should be taken to tackle the exam while taking undergraduate programme itself. Ms. Maria John Paul was the resource person of the workshop. She is the alumna of the Dept. of English. Presently she works as Guest Lecturer, Sacred Heart College, Thevara.

UGC NET or NTA-UGC-NET is the examination for determining the eligibility for the post of assistant professor or Junior Research Fellowship award in Indian universities and colleges. The examination is conducted by National Testing Agency on behalf of University Grants Commission. The NET exam was introduced in the year of 1989. Widely regarded as one of the hardest exams to clear, the winning percentage of the exam is just 6 per cent. Candidates who have secured at least 55% marks (without rounding off) in Master's Degree or equivalent examination from universities or institutions recognised by UGC in Humanities (including languages) and Social Science, Computer Science & Applications, Electronic Science etc. are eligible for this test.

The students who participated in the workshop were able to get a clear vision about the examination and were motivated to try and clear the test in the future. The resource person helped to clear the doubts of the students and acknowledged them about the right methods to prepare for the examinations.






