# Python Programming

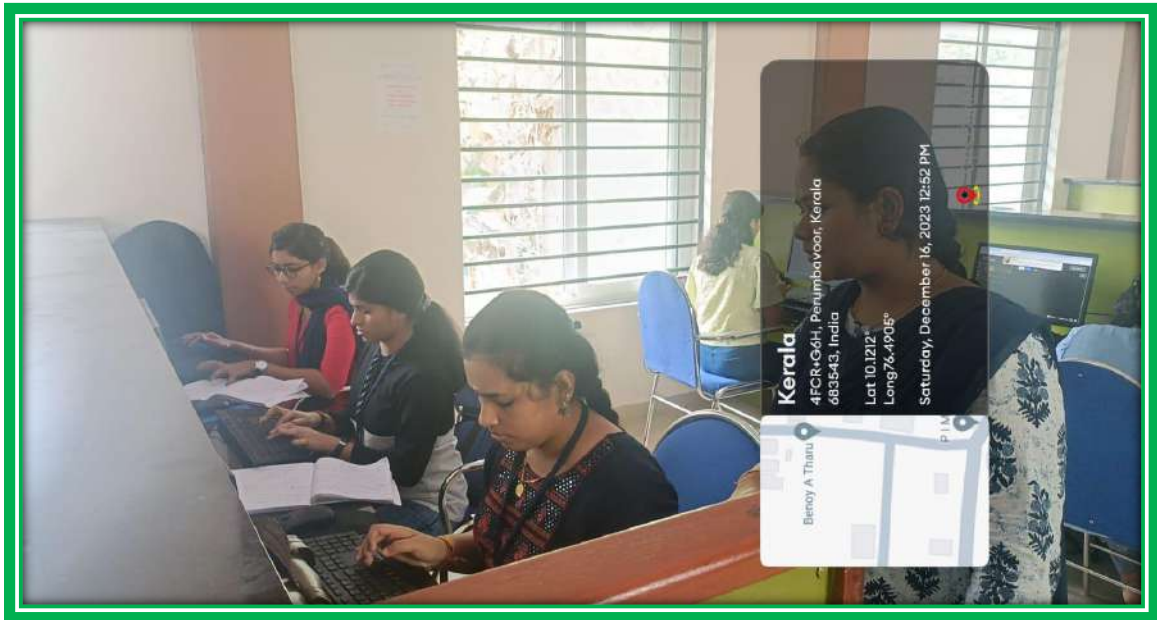
