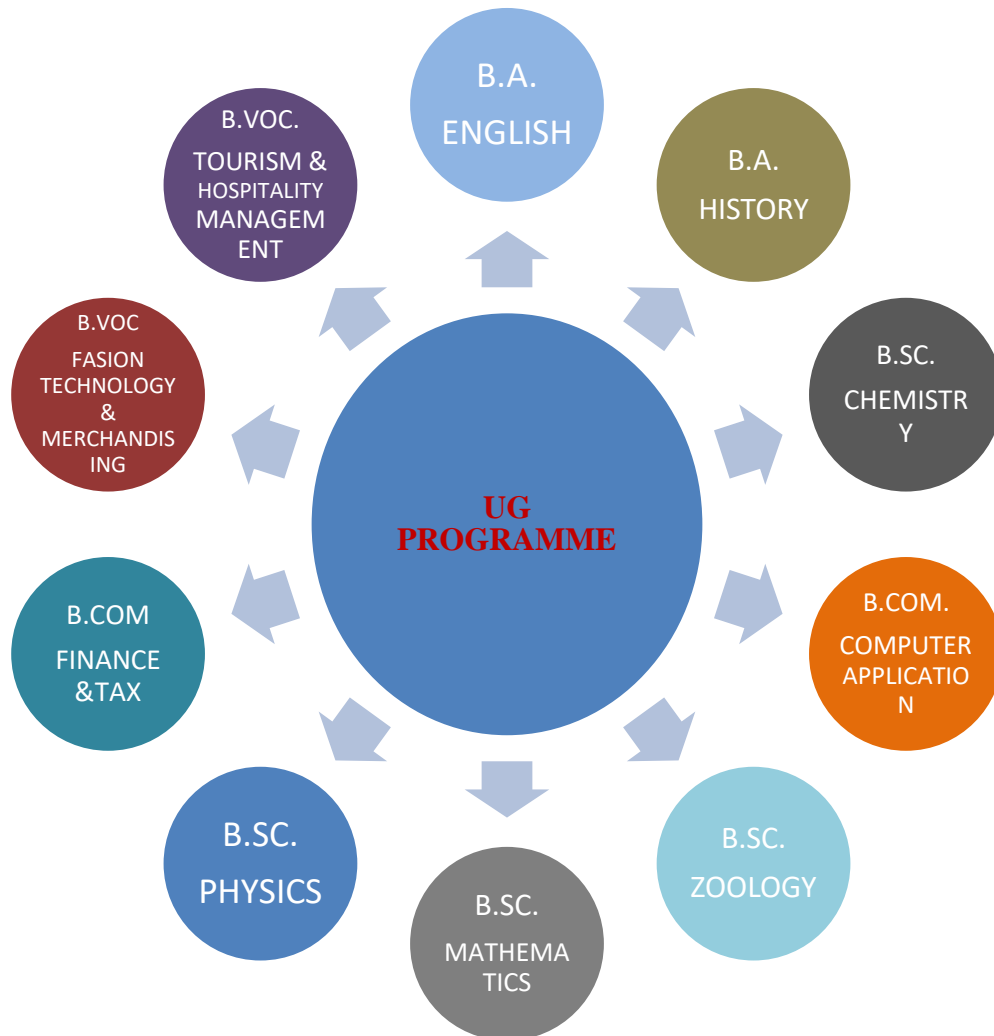
The previous year at Mar Thoma College for Women has been marked by academic success, personal development, and social engagement, reinforcing its commitment to empowering women and shaping future leaders.

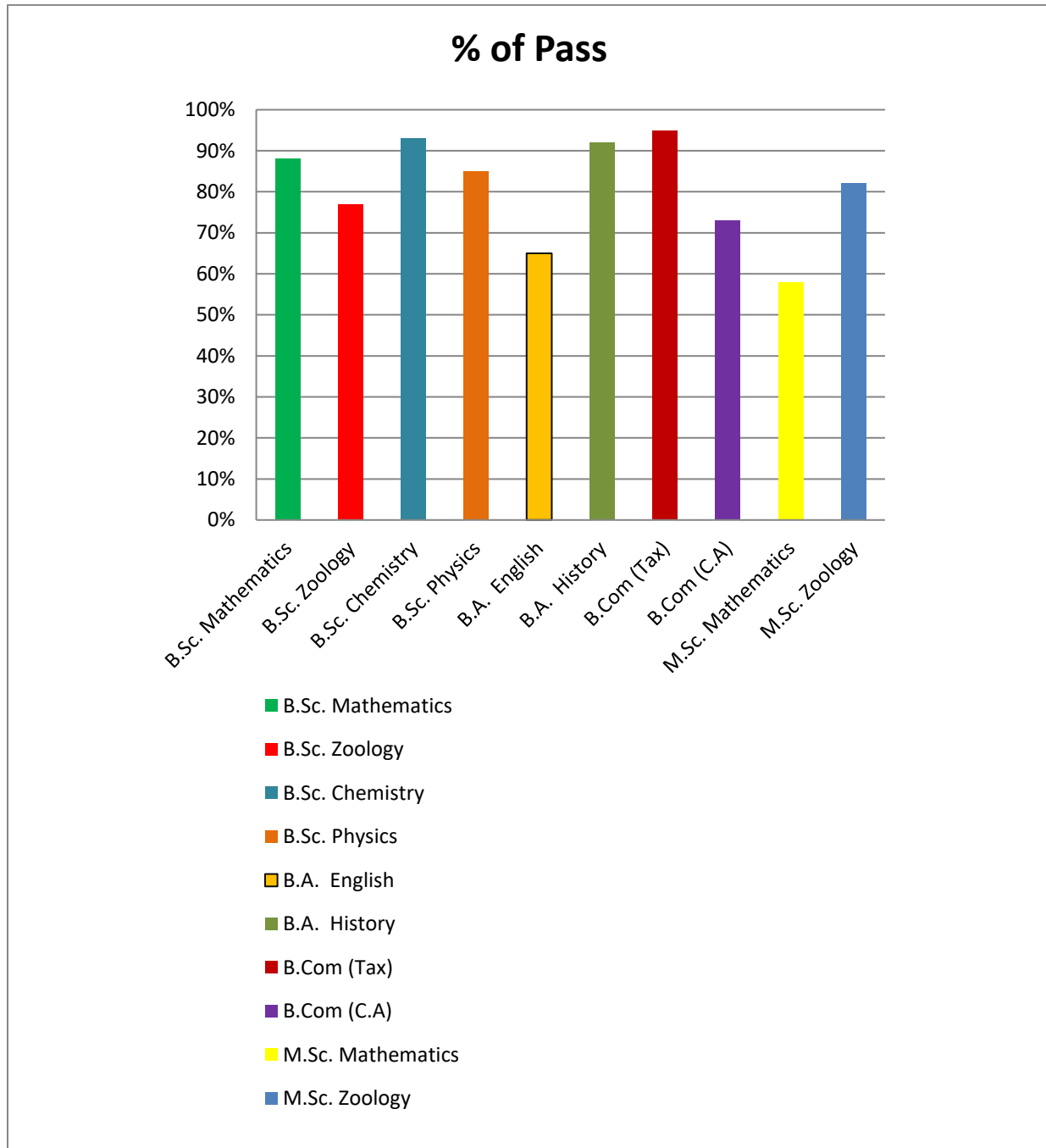
Gopika Vijayan of MSc Zoology (2023 batch) qualified SET.
