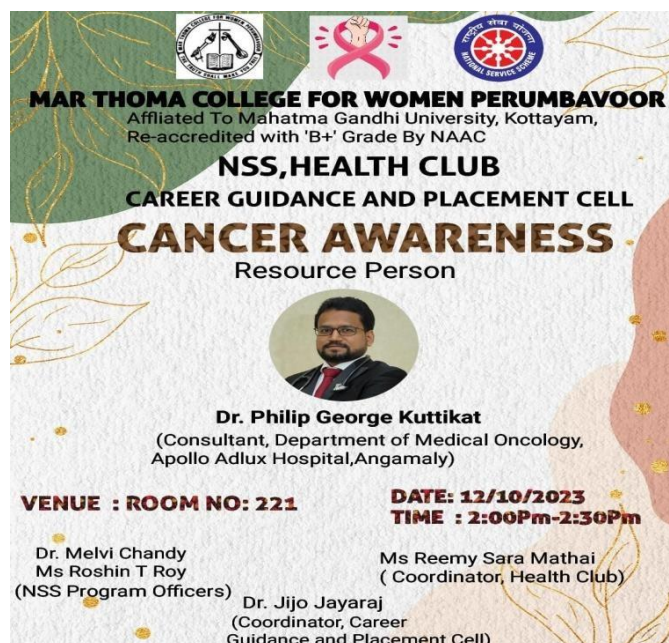

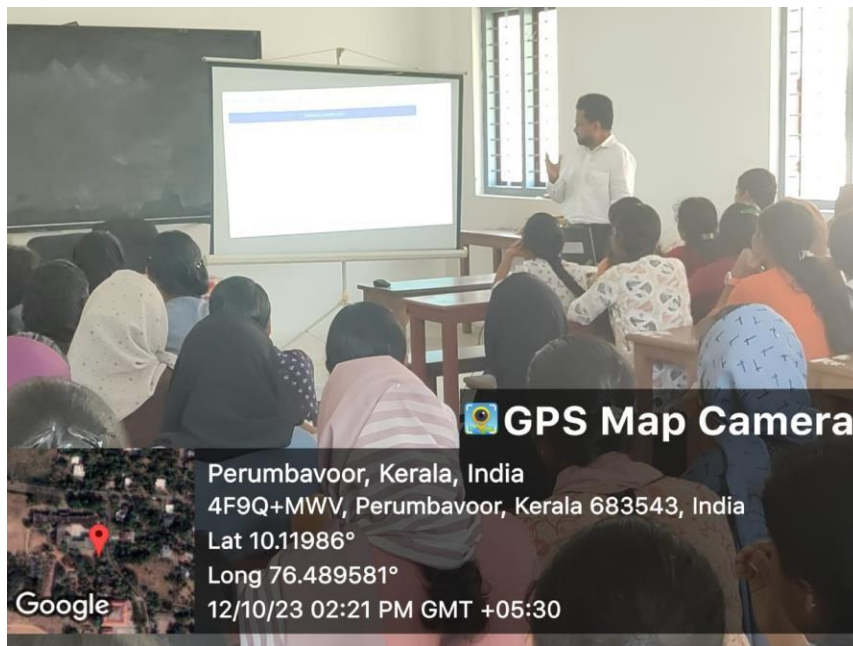

# Cancer Awareness Programme in Association with NSS and Health Club

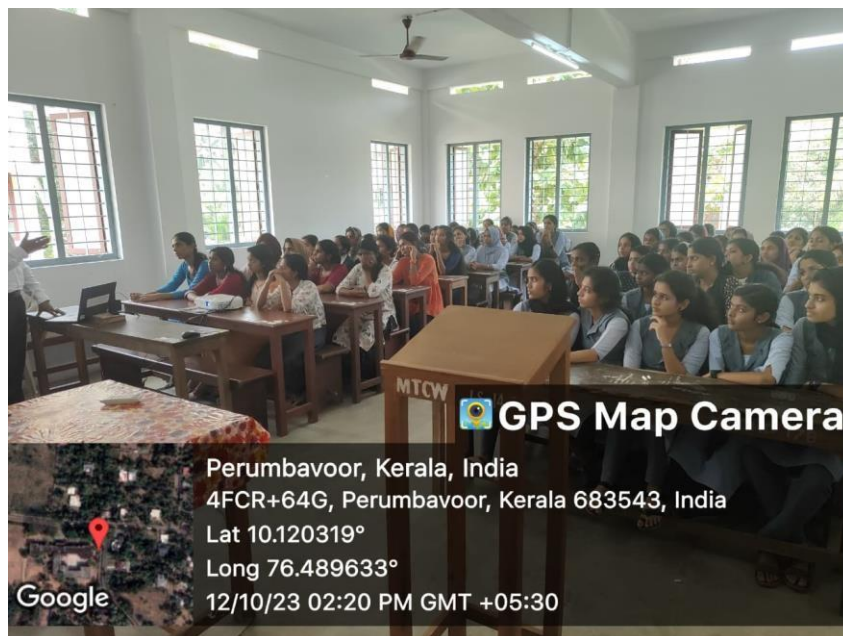
